Employees Show Up, Win Prizes at Asante Fairs

The fairs – which replaced the Employee Communication Events of previous years – were held May 8 at Asante Ashland Community Hospital, May 11 at Asante Three Rivers and May 13 at Asante Rogue Regional.

A total of 1,163 Asante employees attended the fairs and connected with co-workers, participated in activities and visited a variety of booths offering information about key organizational initiatives. Several of the booths offered giveaways or prize drawings, and each of the hospitals featured a grand prize drawing for an Apple iPad Mini.
