Employee fairs offer information, prizes, fun

Question: Where can you learn about Asante's new timekeeping system, update your VIA stickers and ID badge photo, find information on this year's five critical issues and the nursing "vital four," and participate in giveaways or drawings with prizes that range from pens to electronic tablets?

Answer: It depends on the day and date. Next Monday, May 9, the annual Employee Engagement and Communication Fair kicks off at Asante Ashland Community Hospital; it moves on to Asante Rogue Regional on Wednesday, May 11; and wraps up at Asante Three Rivers on Friday, May 13.



The traveling road show will offer information about the organization's latest initiatives, along with interactive activities, prizes and fun.

A total of nine booths hosted by various Asante departments or groups will each have a display or presentation that relates to this year's theme – "One Asante, One Experience."

The Kronos booth will offer information about the new timekeeping system and an opportunity to try out one of the new time clocks; the Values in Action booth will have information about the employee

recognition program and replacements for "blueberry" appliqués; and the ID badge booth will offer the opportunity to update badge photos as Asante gears up for an update to its badge policy.

At the Communications and Marketing booth, participants can play the "Critical Pursuit" game to register for electronic tablet drawings at each hospital; the Asante Physician Partners table will pose a two-question quiz for prize giveaways; and the patient care booth will have "nursing vital four" information on employee engagement, finance, patient safety and patient experience, and a gourmet basket raffle.

The Materials Management table will focus on clinical value analysis and standardized purchasing; Gwen Bratton's prize wheel booth will give participants a chance to spin for a variety of gifts; and the executive team table will offer bag giveaways, a grand prize drawing at each hospital for \$250 worth of points that can be spent at PointRecognition.com, and a chance to chat with Asante's leaders.

Those who attend the fairs can also pick up cookies, peanuts, snack bars and other treats at the various booths.

The Asante Ashland fair will be in Conference Rooms 1 and 2; the Asante Rogue Regional event will be in the hospital's West Lobby, next to the Pear Blossom Café; and the Asante Three Rivers fair will be in Conference Rooms 4-6 at the Asante Center for Outpatient Health.

Each of the one-day events will open at 7 a.m. and close at 4 p.m.

Asante employees who work outside the three hospitals may attend whichever event is closest to their work locations.

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The Employee Engagement and Communication Fairs coincide with National Hospital Week, which is being observed at Asante this year from May 8 to May 14.
